

- 1. Application filed by the Service-Recipient/Applicant to OeKB. Service-Recipients are the organizations executing the project which are in charge of the preparation of the project undertakings.
- 2. Form "Information on Service-Provider" submitted to OeKB by the Service-Provider chosen according to the Application.
- 3. Decision by Austrian MoF based on the Application and the Information on Service-Provider.
- 4. Project Preparatory Agreement (PPA) signed between the Service-Recipient and OeKB/MoF
- 5. Service-Provider Agreement (SPA) signed between the Service-Provider and OeKB/MoF
- 6. Payment of recipient's contribution on an escrow account held by OeKB. Details set out in the PPA.
- 7. Payment according to milestones defined in the SPA.
- 8. Delivery of Service according to the scope set out in the Application/Information on Service-Provider and defined in the SPA.
